TRACE'S STORY

Trace Daniel Bulger

(Jul 19, 1996 – Oct 23, 2019)

Previously, Trace was a healthy and impressive student, athlete, artist, poet, and disciple. In most of his pursuits, Trace was recognized as a leader.

A young man gifted with many talents and big plans for the future. He was strong and principled, as well as compassionate and personable. Others gravitated towards Trace and he thrived when others were counting on him. He was brave in the face of challenge; a fierce but fair competitor. Trace's first name means: courageous, battler, or brave. Trace spent the last 4 years of his life in a fight against a progressive, degenerative, brain disease. He faced this illness with bravery, dignity, and faith. Due to the progressive loss of nerve cells in many areas of his brain, Trace lost the ability to speak, write, walk, eat and other motor functions used in daily living activities. He and his family always held strong in the hope for finding the cause, a diagnosis, treatment, or cure for the disease. Trace Bulger Foundation (TBF)

Founded in 2019, by Trace's friends and family, TBF is dedicated to joyfully remembering and celebrating the life and goals of Trace Bulger.

To begin foundation efforts, TBF held its first golf outing event in June 2019. Last year's goal was to assist the Bulger family with medical expenses and Trace's ongoing needs. The outing was a great success and the family was able to use the donations toward paying off medical bills. Following Trace's passing in Oct 2019, the family was grateful to have the additional financial relief and used another portion of funds to pay for funeral & cemetery expenses.

With TBF's first goal complete, the foundation is now able to put its attention toward the community reflective of Trace's own personal life and goals. While struggling with early disease symptoms, Trace attended a leadership conference in the summer of 2016 in which he kept a journal. In this journal he wrote: "I want to do great things in order to help my community" ...and impress the world "as a man who loved, served, and led his community".

To honor Trace and his goals, the TBF is establishing a memorial scholarship this Spring. Trace was a 2015 Guerin Catholic HS graduate and the scholarship will award a GCHS student entering their Senior year.

In the future, the foundation also plans to support individuals & families affected by degenerative brain disease along with other philanthropic activities. It is the foundation's hope that through continued efforts of generous individuals and corporate sponsors, TBF will continue to evolve as a community leader with the capabilities to serve many deserving people and causes.
