About the Trace Bulger Foundation

In June of 2019, friends and family of the Bulgers held the first Trace Bulger golf outing event to assist the Bulger family with medical expenses and Trace's ongoing needs. The outing was a great success!



In 2020, the Trace Bulger Foundation (TBF) was officially registered as a nonprofit organization and received 501(c)(3) tax exempt status for charitable organizations. The TBF has now turned its attention toward the community reflective of Trace's own personal life and goals.
